SPECIAL CONTRACT TERMS AND CONDITIONS CN00024056 (2420-05)

- 1. <u>CONTRACT SCOPE/OVERVIEW:</u> This Collective No.CN00024056 (Identified here and in the other documents as the "Contract") will cover the requirements of The Commonwealth of Pennsylvania (CWOPA) acting through the Department of General Services (DGS) for the purchase of truck and equipment parts and supplies. (Mandatory for PA-DOT Harrisburg / Optional usage by all other Commonwealth Agencies).
- 2. ORDER OF PRECEDENCE: These Special Contract Terms and Conditions supplement the Standard Contract Terms and Conditions For Statewide Contracts for Supplies. To the extent that these Special Contract Terms and Conditions conflict with the Standard Contract Terms and Conditions for Statewide Contracts for Supplies, these Special Contract Terms and Conditions shall prevail.
- **3. TERM OF CONTRACT:** The Contract shall commence on the Effective Date no earlier than February 1, 2007 and expire on January 31, 2008.
- 4. OPTION TO RENEW: This Contract or any part of the contract may be renewed for four (4) additional one-year(1) terms by mutual agreement between the Commonwealth and the Contractor. In deciding whether to renew, CWOPA will review the contractors' past performance under the contract. If a pricing adjustment is not agreed upon through the negotiation, CWOPA will not renew the contract. The procurement of all parts and supplies regardless of when added to the contract, will expire at the end of the contract, or renewal term(s). If the contract is renewed, the same terms and conditions shall apply.
- 5. OPTION TO EXTEND: The Department of General Services reserves the right, upon notice to the Contractor(s), to extend the Contract or any part of the Contract for up to three (3) months upon the same terms and conditions. This will be utilized to prevent a lapse in Contract coverage and only for the time necessary, up to three (3) months, to enter into a new contract.
- 6. OPTION FOR SEPARATE COMPETITIVE BIDDING PROCEDURE: The Department of General Services reserves the right to purchase supplies covered under this Contract through a separate competitive bidding procedure, whenever the department deems it to be in the best interest of the Commonwealth. The right will generally be exercised only when a specific need for a large quantity of the supply exists or the price offered is significantly lower than the Contract price.
- 7. <u>COSTARS Purchasers.</u> Section 1902 of the Commonwealth Procurement Code, 62 Pa.C.S. § 1902 ("Section 1902"), authorizes local public procurement units and state-affiliated entities (together, "COSTARS Purchasers") to participate in Commonwealth procurement contracts that the Department of General Services ("DGS") may choose to make available to COSTARS Purchasers. DGS has identified this Contract as one suitable for COSTARS Purchaser participation.
 - A. Only those COSTARS Purchasers registered with DGS may participate as COSTARS Purchasers in a Commonwealth contract. Several thousand COSTARS Purchasers are currently registered with DGS; therefore, the Contractor agrees to permit **only** to DGS-registered COSTARS members to make COSTARS purchases from this Contract.
 - 1. A "local public procurement unit" is:
 - Any political subdivision;
 - Any public authority;
 - Any tax exempt, nonprofit educational or public health institution or organization;

- Any nonprofit fire, rescue, or ambulance company; and
- To the extent provided by law, any other entity, including a council of governments or an area government that expends public funds for the procurement of supplies, services, and construction.
- 2. A state-affiliated entity is a Commonwealth authority or other Commonwealth entity that is not a Commonwealth agency. The term includes the Pennsylvania Turnpike Commission, the Pennsylvania Housing Finance Agency, the Pennsylvania Municipal Retirement System, the Pennsylvania Infrastructure Investment Authority, the State Public School Building Authority, the Pennsylvania Higher Educational Facilities Authority and the State System of Higher Education.
- B. COSTARS Purchasers have the option to purchase from a Contract awarded under this procurement, from any DGS contract established exclusively for COSTARS Purchasers in accordance with the requirements of Section 1902, from any other cooperative procurement contracts, or from their own procurement contracts established in accordance with the applicable laws governing such procurements. The Contractor understands and acknowledges that there is no guarantee that any prospective COSTARS Purchaser will place an order under this Contract, and that it is within the sole discretion of the registered COSTARS Purchaser whether to procure from this Contract or to use another procurement vehicle.
- C. DGS is acting as a facilitator for COSTARS Purchasers who may wish to purchase under this Contract. Registered COSTARS Purchasers who participate in this Contract and issue purchase orders ("POs") to Contractors are third party beneficiaries who have the right to sue and be sued for breach of this contract without joining the Commonwealth or DGS as a party. The Commonwealth will not intervene in any action between a Contractor and a Purchaser unless substantial interests of the Commonwealth are involved.
- D. Registered COSTARS Purchasers electing to participate in this Contract will order items directly from the Contractor and be responsible for payment directly to the Contractor.
- E. The Contractor shall furnish to the DGS COSTARS Program Office a quarterly electronic Contract sales report detailing the previous quarter's Contract purchasing activity, using the form and in the format prescribed by DGS. The Contractor shall submit its completed quarterly report no later than the fifteenth calendar day of the succeeding Contract quarter.
- 1. Until such time as DGS may provide the Contractor written notice of automated report filing, the Contractor shall either e-mail the reports to GS-PACostars@state.pa.us or send the reports on compact disc via US Postal Service to the DGS COSTARS Program Office, Bureau of Procurement, 6th Floor Forum Place, 555 Walnut Street, Harrisburg, PA 17101. When DGS has instituted automated reporting, the Contractor shall comply with DGS's written notice and instructions on automated Contract reports. DGS will provide these instructions with sufficient advance time to permit the Contractor to undertake automated reporting.
- 2. The Contractor shall include on each report the Contractor's name and address, the Contract number, and the period covered by the report. For each PO received, the Contractor shall include on the report the name of each COSTARS-Registered Purchaser that has used the Contract along with the total dollar volume of sales to the specific Purchaser for the reporting period.

- 3. DGS may suspend the Contractor's participation in the COSTARS Program for failure to provide the Quarterly Sales Report within the specified time.

- 1. If the Contractor is aware of any qualified entity not currently registered and wishing to participate in the COSTARS Program, please refer the potential purchaser to the DGS COSTARS Website at www.dgs.state.pa.us/costars, where it may register by completing the online registration form and receiving DGS confirmation of its registration. To view a list of currently-registered COSTARS member entities, please visit the COSTARS website.

8. PRICE LISTS: Contractors agree to supply the Commonwealth with copies of the Catalogues and Price Lists as requested by using agencies. All price lists/catalogs must be identified in the bid proposal.

Any reference, which may appear on any price list, to any terms and conditions, such as F.O.B. shipping point, minimum order quantity or amount, or Prices subject to change, will not be a part of any contract and will be disregarded by the Commonwealth.

For Cataloged items the price paid by the Commonwealth shall be the Manufacturer's "Official" Referenced Price List minus the percentage discount, bid to, and accepted by the Commonwealth.

It shall be understood that the pricing offered by the contractor to the Commonwealth shall be equal to or lower than that offered to the contractor's most favored customer(s).

- 9. MINIMUM ORDER: The minimum order under this contract shall be \$500.00. Orders under \$500.00 may be delivered with additional freight cost added to invoice if agreeable to both user and seller. Vendors shall provide ordering agencies with written quotes of additional freight charges prior to shipment.
- 10. <u>PERFORMANCE:</u> The proposed unit shall be identical with the standard or improved model and a current production unit in use by the industry for the past twelve months preceding this bid opening. It shall be the responsibility of the bidder to assure that the proposed equipment conforms to the specifications and performs satisfactorily according to the specifications for the item.
- **11. PACKAGING:** Unless otherwise stated in the specification, packaging shall be One (1) per box, with part number identification.
- **12.** <u>DELIVERY</u>: <u>ALL</u> Deliveries over \$500 will be <u>F.O.B. DESTINATION</u> to any using agencies within the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

Contractor will be responsible for delivery of items on a (30) thirty-day basis unless otherwise specified in the commodity specification.

FOR ALL DELIVERIES TO PENNDOT EQUIPMENT DIVISION:

*****SAFETY***** Skidding for all shipments to Penn DOT Equipment Division: Skidding shall be 36" wide by 42" long. Product, including skid, shall be no more than 48" in height and shall be shrink wrapped or banded.

IF THE MEASUREMENTS ARE NOT ADHERED TO, THE SHIPMENT WILL BE TURNED DOWN UNTIL CORRECT SKIDDING MEASUREMENTS ARE MET.

<u>PILOT MODEL</u>: The successful bidder shall furnish one (1) complete pilot model meeting all the specifications within fifteen (15) days of receipt of the purchase order. Pilot model shall be delivered to the Department of Transportation, 17th & Arsenal Blvd., Harrisburg, PA, ATTN: Sherri Linen for inspection, testing and approval by the Department of Transportation prior to shipment.

Contact Sherri Linen at (717) 787-3959 three (3) days prior to delivery date for delivery instructions. Please contact Sherri before shipping any partial backorders.

All material must be delivered between 8:00 am and 2:30 pm

<u>All orders other than PennDOT Equipment Division</u> may be shipped on standard skids. Product, including skid, shall be no more than 48" in height and shall be shrink wrapped or banded.

- 13. <u>RETURN POLICY:</u> In the event CWOPA should have parts for return (i.e. Due to overstocking, product obsolescence, and others) over the period of one (1) year after purchase from this contract, as long as the items are unused and in new condition, CWOPA will be refunded for the full amount of the parts in hand or if it chooses so, it shall have the privilege of exchanging these for new items. For return purposes, it will be necessary for CWOPA to provide proof of actual pricing paid (i.e. copy of original invoice) for parts being returned. No Restocking Fee shall apply.
- 14. WARRANTY: Unless otherwise stated in the specification the vendor will replace, free of charge within one (1) from date of sale, any product which in the judgment of the manufacturer has failed because of defective material or workmanship, provided it is shown to be properly mounted, and not subject to abuse in operation or assembly.

OR

The standard manufacturer's warranty for all products provided unless otherwise specified in the Item Specification whichever is more advantageous to the Commonwealth.

15. PRICE ADJUSTMENTS: Contractor's pricing for Lines bid by a fixed price, shall remain firm for the term of the contract. Items bid as a fixed price shall be considered Core Items. Contractor's pricing for lines bid as discounts from catalog pricing shall remain firm for the initial 90 days of the contract.

A Catalog Price List may be updated in accordance with a Manufacturer's regularly distributed price list change upon 30 days notice on a once every 90 day basis. Price list update shall be for the purpose of pricing or adding items under the Weighted Average Discount method only. The same discount calculated on the contractor's original bid sheet will be applied to the approved updated Manufacturer's Published price list.

At no time are awarded suppliers allowed to unilaterally change products or pricing. Orders will be monitored to ensure compliance.

- 16. ADDITION OF CORE ITEMS: PennDOT may request to add additional Core line items based on a Weighted Average Discount line, if available in a particular group. The line item will be added at the Pre-determined Weighted Average Discount from the awarded supplier. That line shall then be considered a core item and the price shall remained fixed for the remainder of the contract.
- 17. INVOICING: The Contractor will customize invoices to the Commonwealth to mirror the Commonwealth's Purchase Orders, and show the Purchase Order Number on the face of the invoice. The contractor will indicate the date the Purchase Order was received on its invoices. (A copy may be provided to the ordering location upon request.)


